Searching of funding opportunities for you-digital cultural heritage. Horizon Europe and other relevant EU schemes will be scanned regularly (each relevant WP) to diagnose calls in relation to digitization and cultural heritage (including bottom up funding schemes of Horizon Europe; MSCA IF, ERC, RIS, EIC, etc.)

The call related information will be collected, packed and disseminated to TMO members in a digestible way supported by some call related insights where relevant.

Scouts manages TMO's cooperation with its Members' in project consortia.

-) TMO can give Letter of Support to consortia if proposal;
 - is only using free-of-charge the TM services (e.g. project presentation on TM platforms, inclusion of the project in the TM portfolio, application of public TM tools)
 - conforms to the TM vision, scope and objectives.
 - Scouts manages connections and provides LoS
- 2) TMO joins consortia as a **partner** if proposal;
 - applies TM services (e.g. TMO manages the project's dissemination tasks and community brokerage/endorsement, project sustainability is secured by integrating it's tools into the TMO tool set)
 - conforms to the TM vision, scope and objectives.
 - As a partner TMO may deliver services for the proposed project itself or may contract partners with a handling fee
