


Structural Development: EU Regional Partnerships



The Project Scouting Service provides support in pre-proposal, proposal and ne working areas. This will ultimately not only fortify efforts of Time Machine Organisation members and their consortia but even more importantly enhance th chances at success in receiving funding.

- · Information and consultancy concerning relevant third-party funding schemes
- Support to find matching partners for project consortia
- Management of the involvement of the Time Machine Organisation and support for project consortia
- Consultancy and services for proposal preparation

The Project Scouting Service is provided through two strands. On the one hand, the Time Machine Organisation may participate directly in projects – either partner, as coordinator or cooperation is managed via a Letter of Support. On the other hand, members of the Time Machine Organisation may be supported their efforts to prepare and submit project proposals even without any direct participation or support by the TMO.



Deadline **12 January 2021**

Time Machine

DT-TRANSFORMATIONS-24-2020: European Museum Collaboration and Innovation Space

A Coordination and Support Action - 1 Million Euro Budget (Only one project will be funded)

Asks at least 60% of budget to be allocated to third party experimental projects as grants (30.000 each)

Allows museums to cooperate with creative and technology partners in experimental projects to:

- Innovate their day-to-day functions and processes,
- experiment with 3D digitization and AR/VR applications for visitors
- test new business models for their post-crisis recovery.

Expects collaborative project structure:

- the outcomes and documentation of projects shared through a cloud-based collaboration and innovation space
- will serve as sources of reference, best practice and know-how for Museum sector.

TMO is open to collaboration as partner/supporter in multiple consortia!



Current Funding Opportunities at a glance

Time Machine

A new EIT-KIC on Cultural and Creative Industries (CCI)

- European Institute of Technology (EIT) supports long-term European partnerships among leading companies, research labs and higher education called as Knowledge and Innovation Communities (KICs).
 KICs has up to 80 Mio EUR budget.
- 8 KICs are active yet. A new KIC is planned focusing on **cultural and creative industries (CCI): EIT Culture & Creativity**.
- Following inter-institutional negotiations (December 2020), a call could come up following years. A Call is planned for 2021 and new KIC would get started in 2022.
- **TMO** is following both national and European scale engagements towards KIC CCI:
 - o Responded as a partner in national initiatives.
 - Carry out initiatives at European scale: EIT Directorate (follow up of the call) and engagements to European scale consortia.
