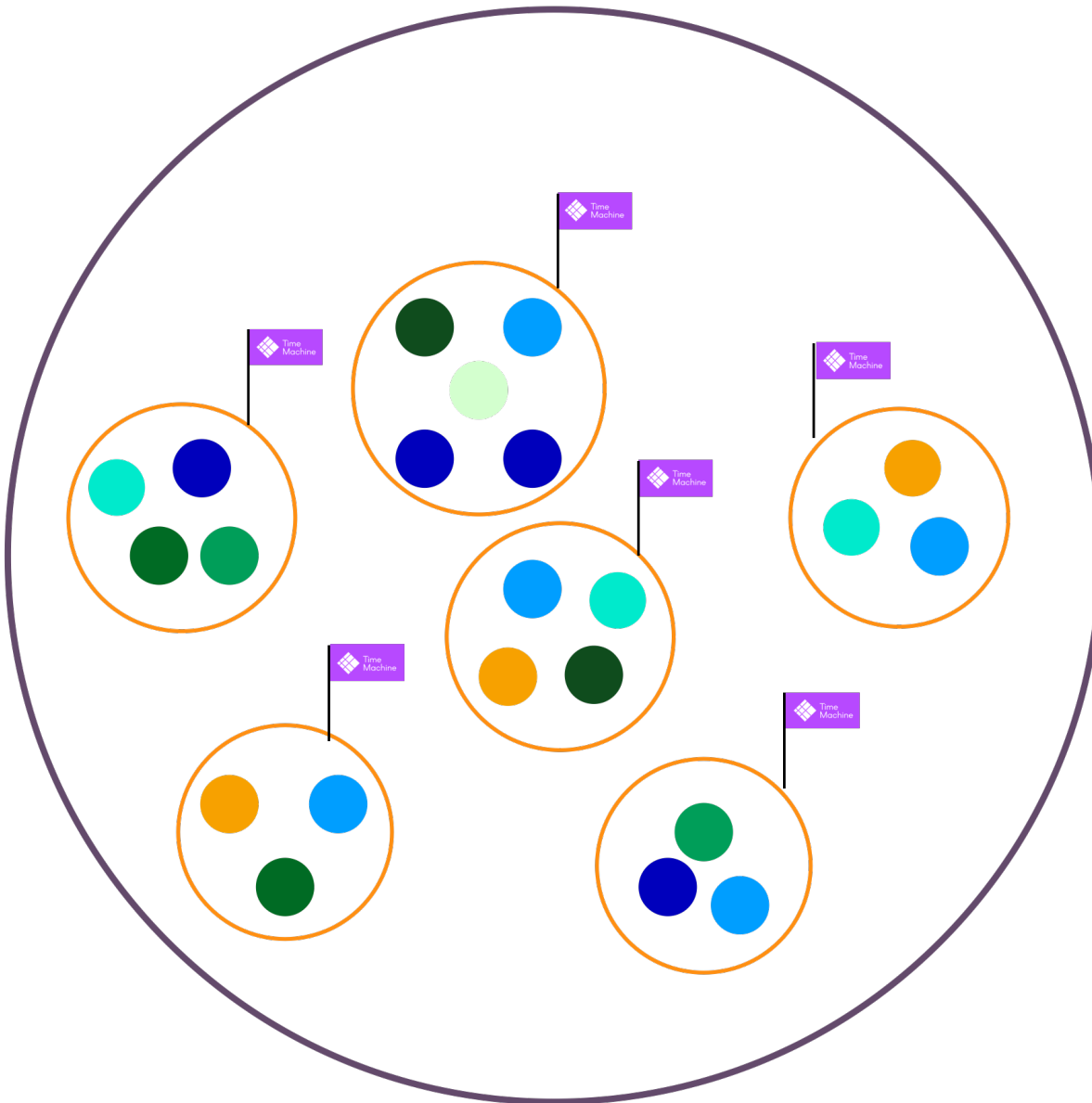




Zone of coverage
