The Digital Heritage Development Platform provides a servicing environment for digital software applications and content development and operation during the full software lifecycle.



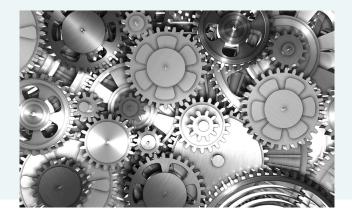
The challenge

Business model
